Centre Assessment

On Tuesday 8 July, 2014, during our winter Vacation Care program, the Centre underwent the National Quality Framework assessment and rating process. This was carried out by the Australian Children's Education & Care Quality Authority (ACECQA) and the Department of Education and Communities. The purpose of the assessment was to determine whether and at what rating level the Centre meets the National Quality Standard, in particular the 7 Quality Areas defined as part of the Framework.

The Centre's ratings were as follows:

Quality Area 3	Physical Environment	Meeting
Quality Area 4	Staffing Arrangements	Meeting
Quality Area 5	Relationships with Children	Meeting

Quality Area 7	Leadership and Service Management	Working Towards

The overall result of the review was that OOSH was given a final rating of Working Towards the National Quality Standard. The areas that were rated as Working Towards as part of the assessment have now been addressed by the Committee and OOSH Staff, and we believe that we are meeting the National Quality Standard for these two areas.

In addressing these areas, we have:

- amended and/or added policies that were identified as requiring change. Generally these changes do not impact on the way we operate the Centre or your interaction with the Centre. There will be some additional requirements for parents of children with medical conditions - further information will be sent to these families.
- implemented some changes to our programming - the suggestions book next to the sign on sheet is part of this.

OOSH and Vacation Care Fees

Non - Notification Fee

A reminder to all parents that failure to inform the Centre of your child/s absence will result in a fee of \$15. Failure to notify results in staff members having to take time away from supervising the children to contact parents and locate missing children, affecting the staff to child ratios.

Online Bookings

Please ensure that you are using the online system whenever possible for booking changes. If you have missed the deadline (i.e. past midday the day before for casual changes, or past Friday 9am the week prior for permanent changes) then you will need to either call, email or come and speak to the Centre in person to inform of the required changes.
